A CLOSER LOOK AT THE EXPANSION

What Does The Building Expansion Include?

- Improved entrance/exit
- 78% more parking (142 parking spaces)
- Car port on east building entrance for inclement weather loading/unloading
- 35% more building (7388 sq ft)
- 25% more seating in the sanctuary (100 seats)
- 60% more classroom space (3 classrooms)
- 66% more White Box space
- 33% more cafe space
- 200% more storage space
- media studio
- 1600 sq ft of undesignated space
- 7200 sq ft multi-purpose barn-like structure (60'x120')... this is not included in this capital campaign, but will be built based on church's needs after this phase of expansion is completed
